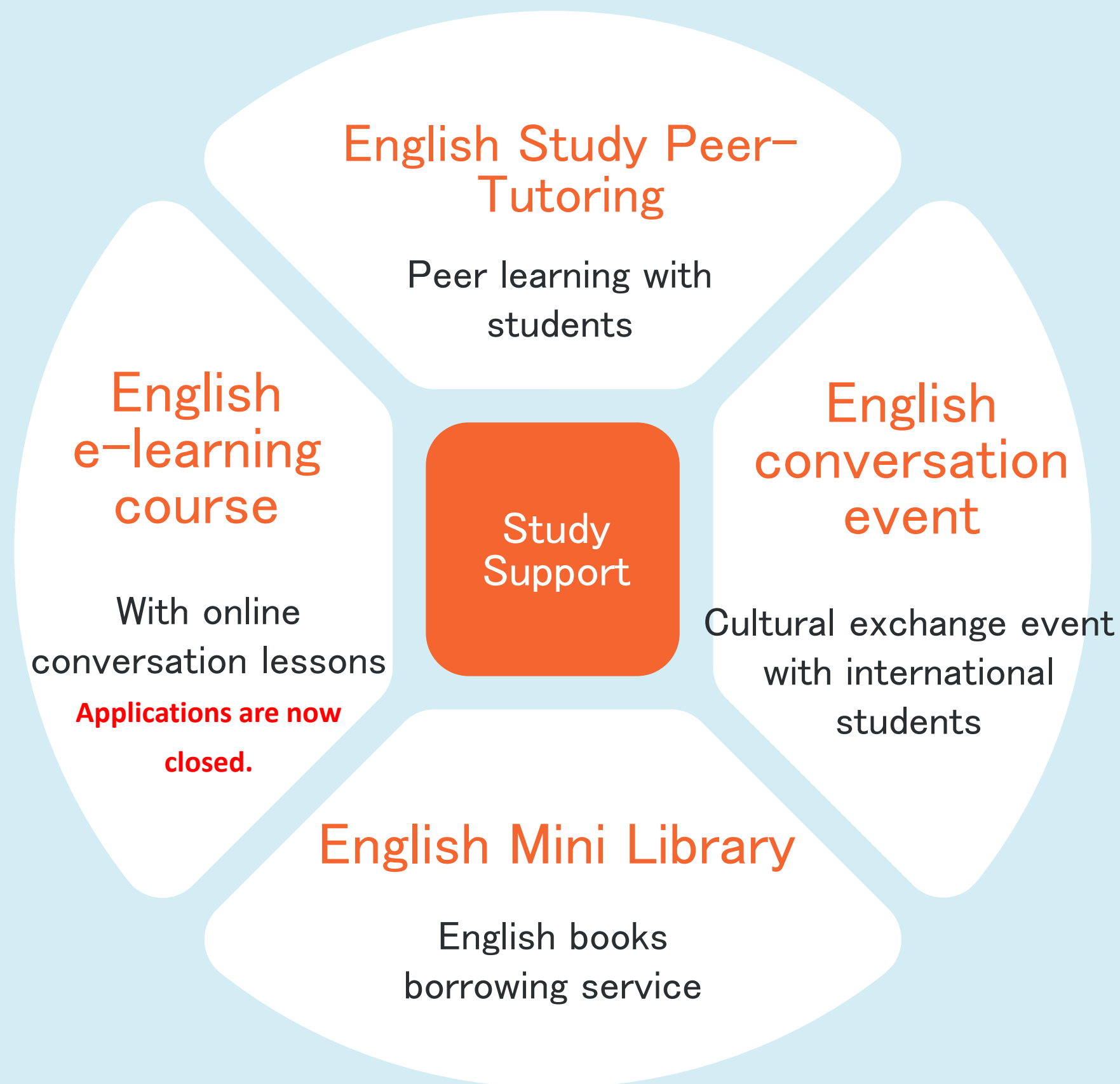

English Study Peer-Tutoring

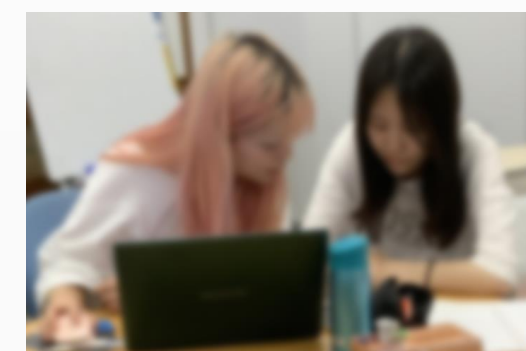
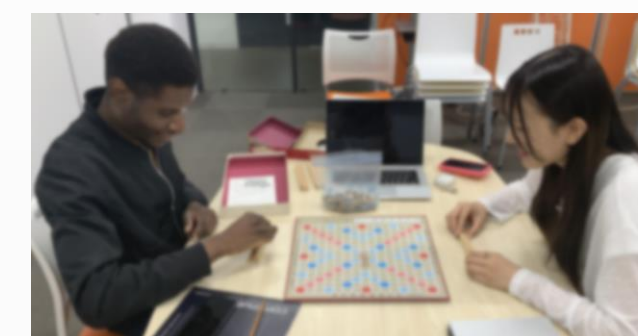
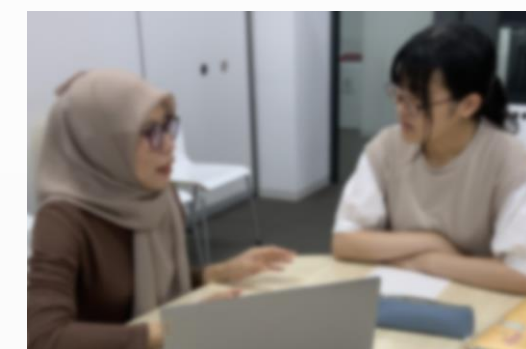
One-on-one English lessons by AUE students

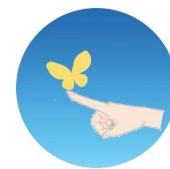


Feedback from English tutors:

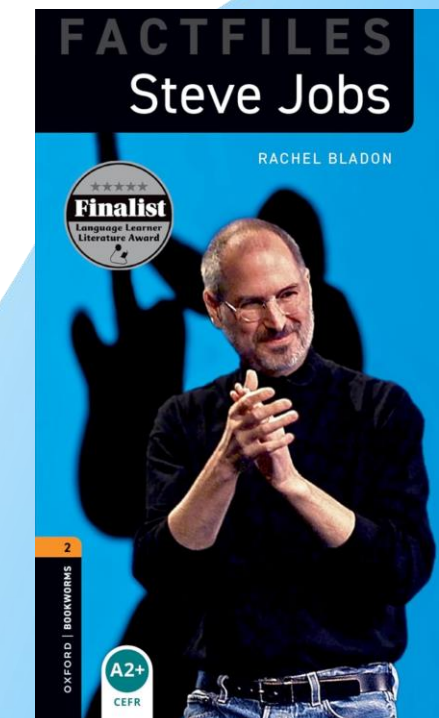
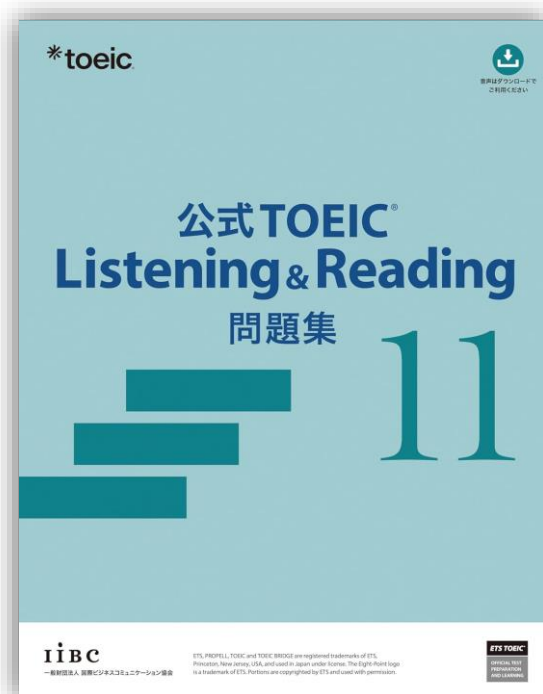

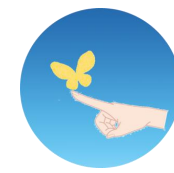
