

## 学長挨拶

愛知教育大学の学部は、明治6年に開校した愛知県養成学校に始まり、昭和24年に設置した教員養成課程と、平成29年に設置したばかりで令和2年度にようやく4年生まで揃う教育支援専門職養成課程（心理コース、福祉コース、教育ガバナンスコース）からなります。令和2年4月に、これまであった修士課程と教職大学院の2つの大学院を大きく改組しました。教職大学院を教育学研究科に一本化し、実践的なキャリアアップの場として位置付け、学校・地域および教育関係諸機関との連携を生かしつつ、さらなる学校教育の質的向上を目指します。学生定員が50名であった教職大学院の定員を120名にして、教育実践高度化専攻としました。専攻には、学校マネジメントコース、教科指導重点コース、児童生徒発達支援コース、地域・教育課題解決コースの4コースがあります。これは愛知県内唯一の教職大学院です。修士課程は教育支援高度化専攻（定員30名）として、臨床心理学コースと留学生対象の日本型教育グローバルコースが設置されています。また、本学は後期3年博士課程も有しており、教科開発分野における研究力・実践力を持つ人材の育成も行っています。

学部は令和3年度から、現在の教員養成課程を「学校教員養成課程」に改組する申請をしています。認可後、学校教員養成課程の中に、幼児教育専攻、義務教育専攻、高等学校教育専攻、特別支援教育専攻、養護教育専攻が位置付きます。カリキュラムも学校体験、多文化体験、自然体験、企業体験など活動を通して体験的に学ぶ科目と、大学での講義・演習科目などにつながりをもたせる工夫をしてきました。また、アクティブ・ラーニングに対応できる学習環境も整え、約6割の科目でアクティブ・ラーニングを取り入れています。

古くは名古屋と岡崎にキャンパスがありましたが、1970年に現在の刈谷市井ヶ谷に統合移転され、今年で50周年を迎えます。緑豊かなこのキャンパスは、四季折々の自然の変化を味わうことができ、教員や教育を支える専門職として必要な豊かな感性を磨くには最適であると思います。本学のシンボルマークは、愛知県の花でもある「カキツバタ」をデザインしたものです。大学から徒歩20分程度のところに、日本三大カキツバタ自生地の一つである「小堤西池のカキツバタ群落」（国指定天然記念物）があり、5月には一面に美しい花を咲かせます。私は、シーズンになると早朝に何度か足を運びます。

私は、学生の皆さんが「この大学に入学してよかった」「この先生や職員に出会えてよかった」と感じるような大学に、大学教員、附属学校の教員、事務職員、地域の方々そして学生の皆さんと一丸となつてしていきたいと考えています。

また、中部地区の広域拠点型教員養成大学として、地域での大学間の連携を一層推進し、新たな価値の創造に向けて挑戦し続ける姿や成果を全国に発信したいと思います。

## Greetings from the President

Aichi University of Education was established in 1873 under the name Aichi Prefectural Academy. In 2017, in addition to the traditional Teacher Training Programs, new undergraduate Training Programs for Educational Support Professionals, consisting of three courses (Psychology Course, Social Work Course and Educational Administration and Governance Course) were set up and we now have first-year through fourth-year students enrolled in the new programs. The postgraduate school programs went through a large-scale reorganization in April 2020. By merging the Professional School for Teacher Education into Graduate School of Education, we started to offer extensive graduate programs for advanced teacher training and career enhancement, in cooperation with local communities and schools, and other educational organizations. The quota on the Program for Advanced Education Practitioners (the former Graduate School of Practitioners in Education) was increased from 50 to 120, now consisting of four courses (School Management Course, Course Focused on Teaching School Subjects, Course for Supporting Human Development, and Course for Solving Regional and Educational Problems). It is the one and only Professional School for Teacher Education in Aichi Prefecture. Our new master course is called Program for Advanced Education Colleagues, which comprises a Clinical Psychology Course and a Japanese-Style Education Course. Our joint three-year Doctoral Course in Subject Development keeps on producing competent personnel equipped with researching expertise and practical skills.

Moving to our undergraduate programs, our application for unification of the teacher training programs is currently being processed at MEXT. In 2021, we expect to set up a Pre-service Teacher Training Program, consisting of Major in Early Childhood Education, Major in Compulsory Education, Major in High School Education, Major in Special Needs Education, and Major in School Health Education. The new curriculum has been designed to link aspects such as hands-on learning at schools, multicultural experiences, interaction with nature and experiences of cooperating with companies, with the lectures and exercises at university. We have made our lecture halls fit for active learning so that approximately 60% of our courses now adopt it.

Fifty years in 1970, our two separate campuses, one in Nagoya and the other in Okazaki, were merged and moved to the present location in Igaya-cho, Kariya. Surrounded by natural beauty and pure greenery, we have plenty of opportunities to enjoy the beauty of seasonal transitions. Our campus provides an ideal environment for prospective teachers and educational practitioners to cultivate their characters and sensitivity. The emblem of our university features the kakitsubata (rabbit-eared iris), which is also the prefectural flower of Aichi. Kozutsumi Nishi Ike Pond, a natural monument designated by the Government as one of three habitats of kakitsubata in Japan, lies close to our campus (approximately 20 minutes on foot). The beautiful purple flower blooms in profusion in May. Every year in the season I visit the spot several times early in the morning.

I hope all our students will spend well-filled campus life, under the guidance of helpful and pleasant faculty and staff. The friendly relations and cooperation among faculty, affiliated-school teachers, administrative staff, the local community and students themselves are essential for their successful university life.

As the key university of education in Central Japan, Aichi University of Education continues to promote cooperation among the universities in the region and disseminate our successful efforts at creating new values all over the country.
